

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN CHANGES



- The Department of Education proposes limiting PA student loans to **\$20,500** per year, with a \$100,000 lifetime cap.
- This could limit PA school applicants to only those with outside financial support or strong credit to qualify for private loans.
- This could have a devastating impact on **who** and how **many** people will become practicing PAs.
- We already face long waits to see PAs—imagine how much worse it could be for you or your loved ones needing care in the future?
- The Department of Education has opened up for public comment until **March 2, 11:59 PM.**
