Join the CABEC Associate Energy Analyst / Certified Energy Analyst Mentorship Program

The CABEC Associate Energy Analyst and Certified Energy Analyst (AEA/CEA) Mentorship Program is a unique, 11-month program designed for building industry practitioners who work with California's Building Energy Efficiency Standards (Title 24, Part 6 or the Energy Code). Gain the knowledge and confidence to apply the Energy Code, earn professional recognition, and expand your network.

## Why Participate?

Energy Consultants, Designers, and Energy Professionals have limited capacity to stay up to date on Energy Code requirements. As complexity of the Energy Code increases, expertise needed to document and verify compliance grows.

CABEC's AEA/CEA Mentorship Program scales Energy Code expertise throughout California and supports the use of credentialed experts for completion and review of Energy Code compliance documentation and plans prior to permit application, or for verification of compliance during plan check.

- ➔ Accelerate your ability to interpret and apply Energy Code requirements
- ➔ Increase permit applications and inspections that meet the Energy Code—the first time
- ➔ Deepen your understanding of energy efficiency's impact on cost savings and greenhouse gas reduction

## What to Expect

The AEA/CEA Mentorship Program combines structured training, hands-on practice, and one-on-one mentoring:

- Two cohorts offered concurrently, one for nonresidential/multifamily buildings and another for single-family residential buildings
- Limited group size to facilitate discussion and learning among cohort members and mentor
- Monthly virtual meetings during the work week to explore key code topics and discuss real-world plan checks and inspections
- Live online training led by industry experts
- Regular “Study Halls” for personalized Q&A with different mentors
- Practical exercises integrated into your daily workflow

### Commitment

Approximately 10 hours per month, entirely online—participate from home or the office.

A fee of \$475 covers the mentorship program, AEA/CEA exam, and a one year CABEC membership.
